## Policing of Tenby and Saundersfoot - Summer 1971

#### INTRODUCTION

It has been decided to provide additional police cover at TENBY and SAUNDERSFOOT during the summer months. To achieve this, the following arrangements will be made for the 12 week period commencing on the 20th June and concluding on the 12th September, 1971.

    - (ii) At SAUNDERSFOOT, cover by 1 Constable for 24 hours.
